

Major changes, including a huge increase in prize money, are in store for the 2015 RAM National Circuit Finals Rodeo and each of the 12 members of the Circuit System. The 10-year contract the PRCA signed with Las Vegas Events in 2014 will add a total of \$1.2 million per year to the Circuit System. The payout at the annual RNCFR will increase to more than \$1 million in cash and prizes.

Kissimmee, Fla., is the new home of the RNCFR, and will host the rodeo through 2024. This year's event is scheduled March 25-28 at the Silver Spurs Arena. The RNCFR committee will pay entry fees for all contestants, who will also be guaranteed a \$1,000 qualifying bonus. The payout for winners of all go-rounds and the average will be \$6,181. Winners of the semifinal and final rounds will earn \$7,493.

Also beginning in 2015 and lasting for 10 years, LVE funds will add \$100,000 to each of the 12 circuits, with \$65,000 of that being dedicated to the prize money of each Circuit Finals Rodeo.
